Essential Learning Outcomes

- Introduce and enhance children's experience of live music
- Explore live genres of music through a modern context
- Introduce and reinforce the key concepts and definitions used in music through relevant examples (rhythm/pitch/dynamics/timbre etc)
- Experience performing where and when appropriate i.e. playing percussion.
- Enhance listening skills by giving learners the opportunity to hear concepts in a live performance context.
- Enhance appreciation of a variety of styles of music
- Learn how feelings and emotions can be recognised and represented through music where appropriate.
- Work in partnership with professional musicians and as part of a team. i.e. children playing instruments
- Learning transferable skills that can be applied in other areas of the curriculum such as listening and communication skills
- Approach different genres of music with new and informed ideas
- Enhance the understanding of culture in Scotland and beyond

We strongly believe that music should provide children with opportunities to contribute to, reflect on and respond to music within their own culture and that of others. As all education work within EMS is devised with regard to the learning needs of our specific audiences the outcomes above provide a general framework for all workshops.
