

Enterprise Music Scotland Promoter Funding
Guidance for Completing the Application Form

This fund is to support high quality chamber music concerts across Scotland. These public funds, devolved to EMS from Creative Scotland, are available to support local promoters working to ensure that audiences across the country have access to live chamber music and that artists are paid appropriately. Applicants will be assessed on these criteria, the financial information submitted, programme of work (concerts), as well as the information given in response to Q2-5 of the Application Form - Connecting the Network and Supporting the Sector, Community, Fundraising and Excellence and Experimentation.

Applicants can apply for up to a maximum of £3000.00.

Please note that we expect the demand for support to be in excess of the total funding available and we may not be able to support all applications submitted.

All awards will be in the form of an 'up-front' payment in July/August 2018. Guarantees against loss will no longer be offered. Any existing GALs offered in 2017 will still be paid out in July/August 2018.

Eligible to apply:

Organisations delivering a series of chamber music concerts in Scotland featuring professional chamber musicians which are open to the public to attend.

What we can't support:

Applications from organisations/individuals already receiving funding from Creative Scotland for this activity.

If you are a multi-arts promoter applying for support for a chamber music series, the information and budget figures submitted should be relevant to the chamber music activities only.

Notes on Application Form Questions

We have asked you to answer 5 questions about what you will be doing in 2018/19. This is an opportunity to strengthen your application.

Q1. Overview

Tell us what you are planning to do in 2018/19 and what you are asking EMS to support.

Q2. Connecting the Network & Supporting the Sector.

- In Scotland we are unique in having a nationwide network of local chamber music promoters, working together to provide performance opportunities for musicians and a chance for audiences to enjoy high-quality concerts. EMS provides network events such as Regional Gatherings, Tours

Conference and Showcase (2018) to bring promoters together, offer development sessions and showcase Scottish talent. We want all organisations within the network to attend as many as possible of these events. Please provide information on which EMS Network events you attended in 2017/18 and which ones you will be attending in 2018/19.

- Please highlight how you will support Scottish based musicians/ensembles and works from Scottish based composers in your planned programme.

Q3. Your community

Please detail any examples of how you will engage with your local community. Examples may include:

- Audiences
- Learning events/workshops at schools, nurseries, care homes etc.
- Working with other community groups in your area
- Involvement in community events
- Involvement in National Chamber Music Day
