Join **Enterprise Music Scotland** on Saturday the 14<sup>th</sup> of September for National Chamber Music Day 2019! We will be celebrating chamber music throughout the country with 30 events including collaborations, workshops and free concerts, all featuring some of our finest chamber musicians.

Look out for **concerts in public spaces** involving the National Mining Museum, Glenfinnan Station, The Scottish Poetry Library, An Tobar and more. We're excited to be working with over **20 partnership organisations** including Live Music Now! Scotland, National Youth Orchestras of Scotland, Barrowland Ballet, Sistema Scotland, Hospitalfield and The Cumnock Tryst.

There will be music for residents, friends and families in Care Homes from Moffat to Mull and we'll be including a new **intergenerational** element to the day, bringing together people of all ages to explore chamber music.

Young musicians from Sistema Scotland in Aberdeen will be visiting residents of Torry Nursing Home for an interactive music session with The Avanti Duo. In Dumfries, music lovers of all ages can join in the fun with a workshop on improvisation from the Glasgow Improvisors Orchestra. Wee ones can also attend a GIO Babies session, created especially for early years. Along with their 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary, The National Youth Orchestras of Scotland will be celebrating NCMD with their very own wind quintet concert featuring current NYOS members and alumni including RSNO Associate Principal Oboe, Peter Dykes.

We are also launching an exciting **cross-arts collaboration** between Barrowland Ballet's intergenerational company, The Wolf Pack and the Broen Ensemble. This new team will spend NCMD working together, exploring traditional chamber music works, improvisation and movement.

Be sure to catch our new Ensemble in Residence **GAIA** who will be travelling from the bottom to the top (yes you heard us!) of Scotland with their "Lost and Found" tour. The duo will unveil the unheard voices of female Scottish composers discovered within archives of the National Libraries of Scotland, sharing the stories behind these 18th century works of art with audiences from Gretna to Brough Bay.
